- The Retreat, a former Rectory to St Matthews Church was rebuilt in 1744, the year before Bonnie Prince Charles arrived at Swarkstone Bridge and encamped in Derby, is a fine Georgian mansion style house complete with Chapel, accommodation block and wardens cottage.
